

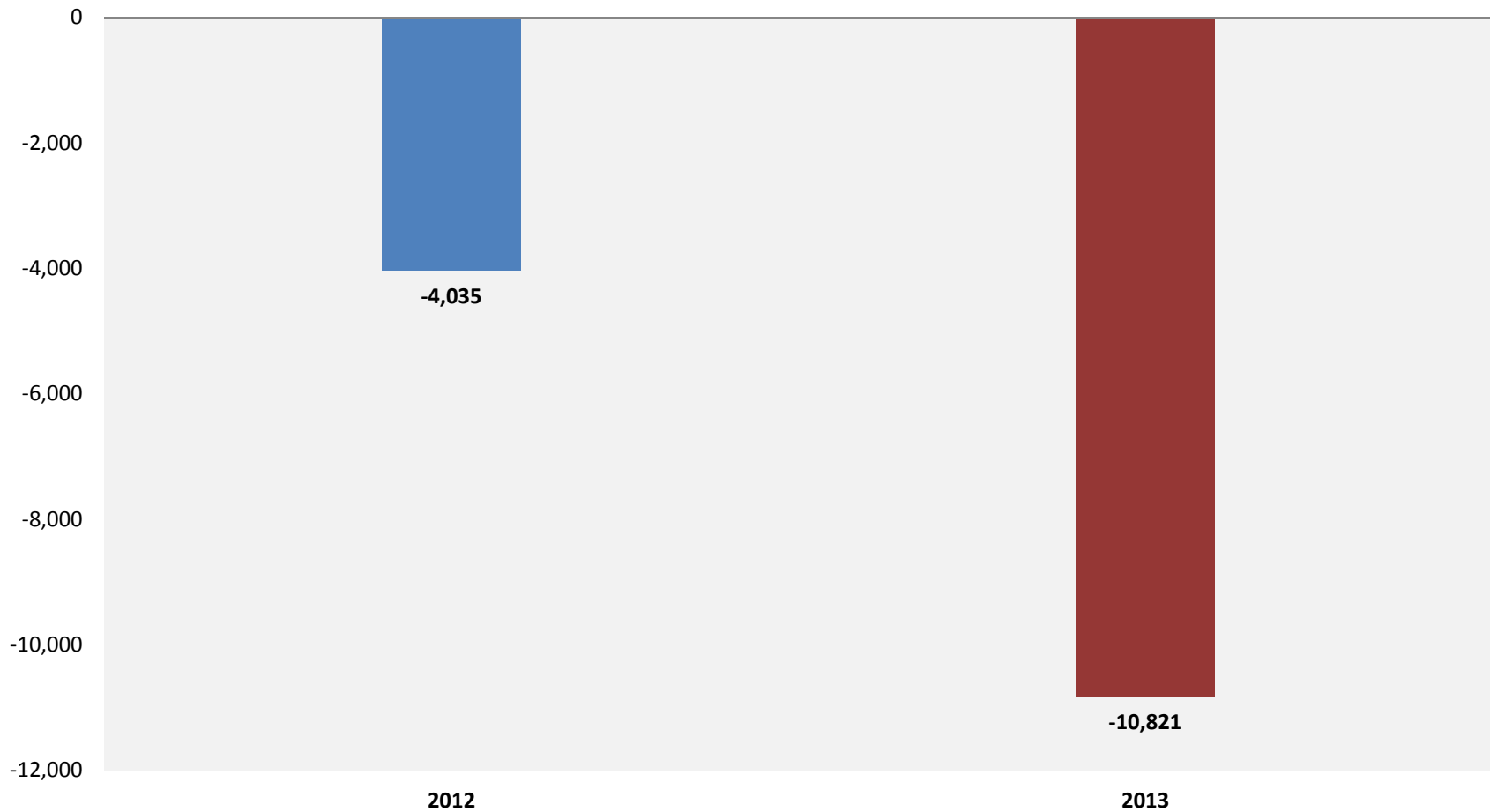

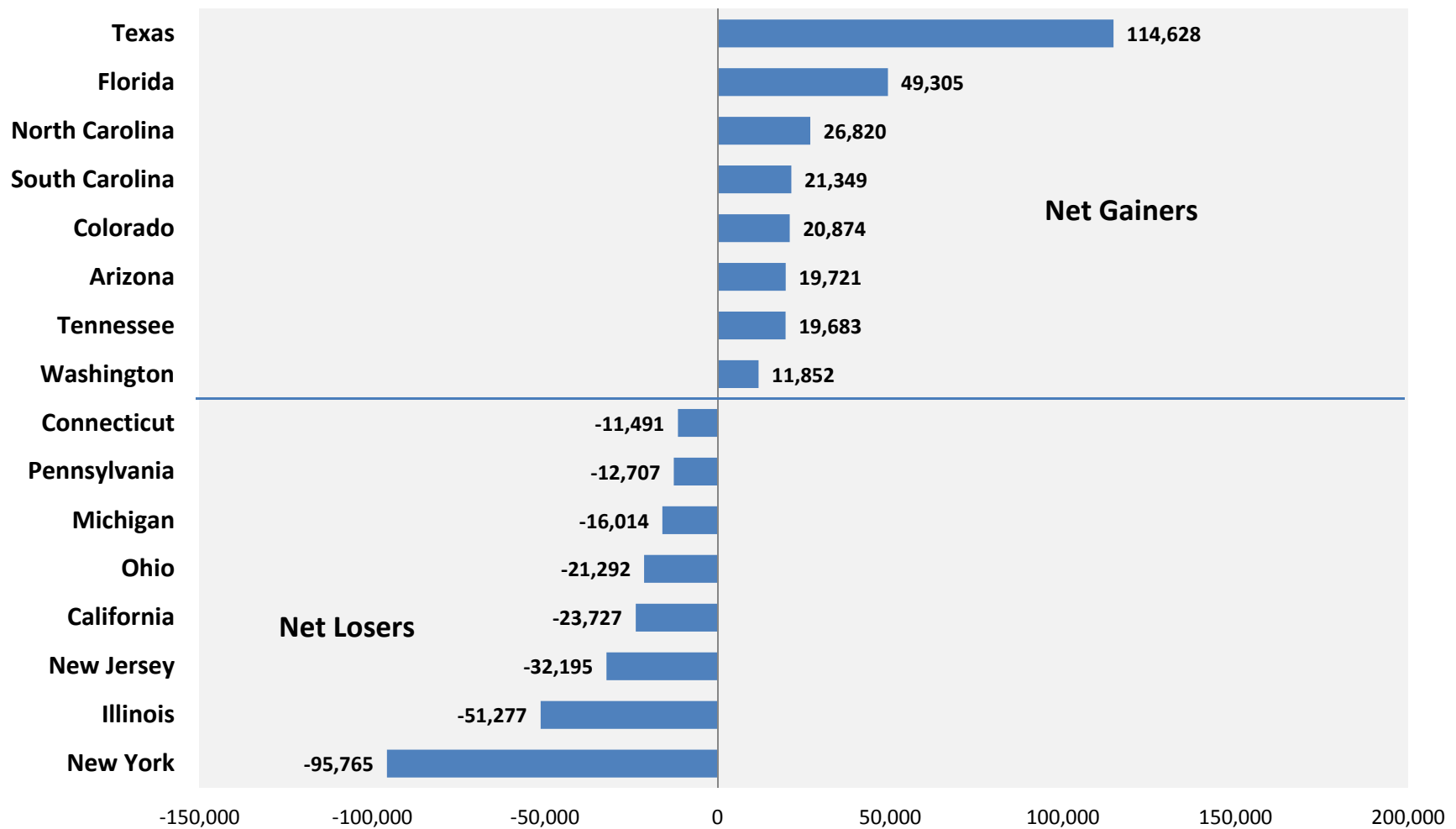

Net Migration for Maryland *



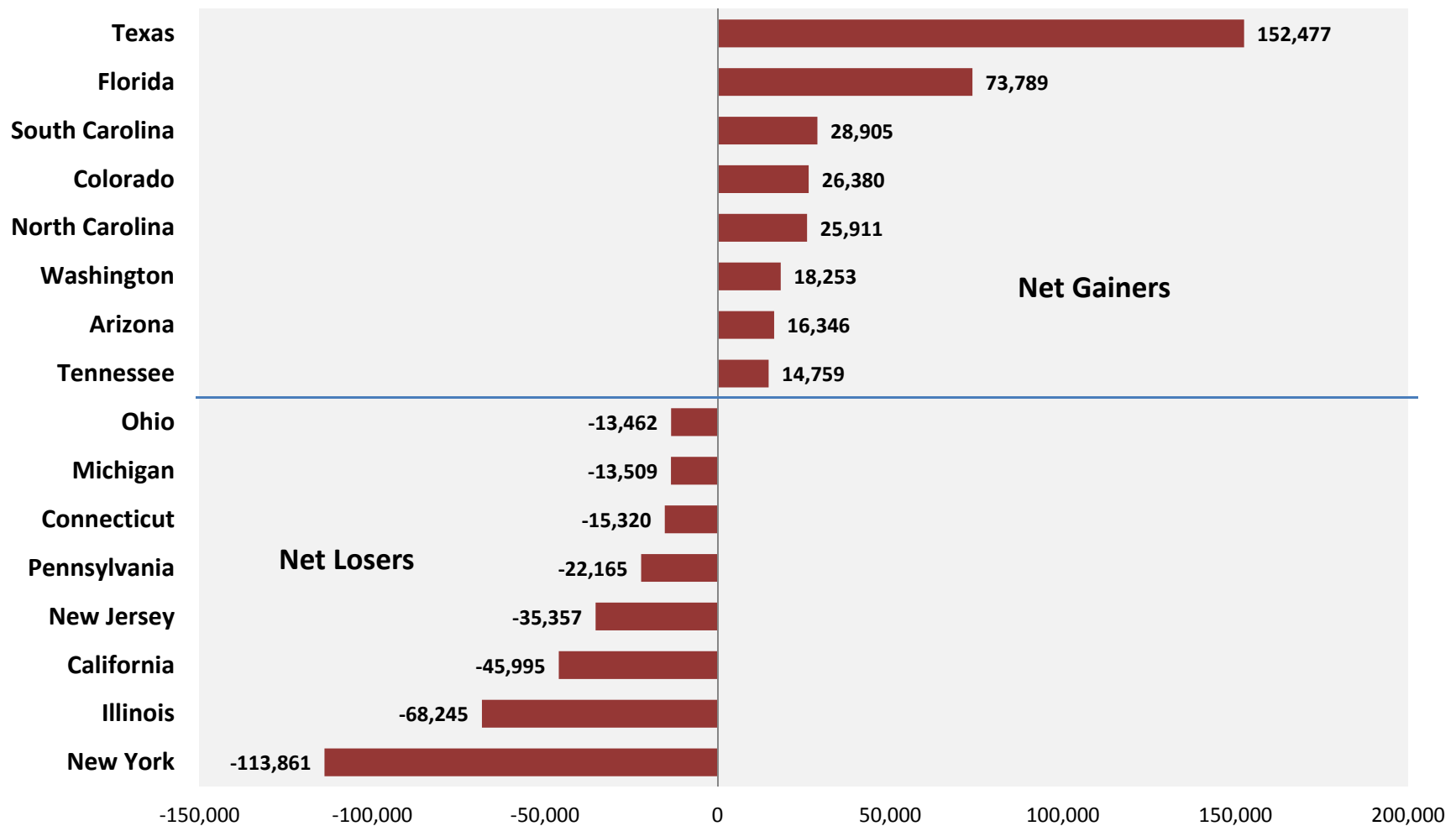

Largest Net In and Out Migration by State for 2011-2012*



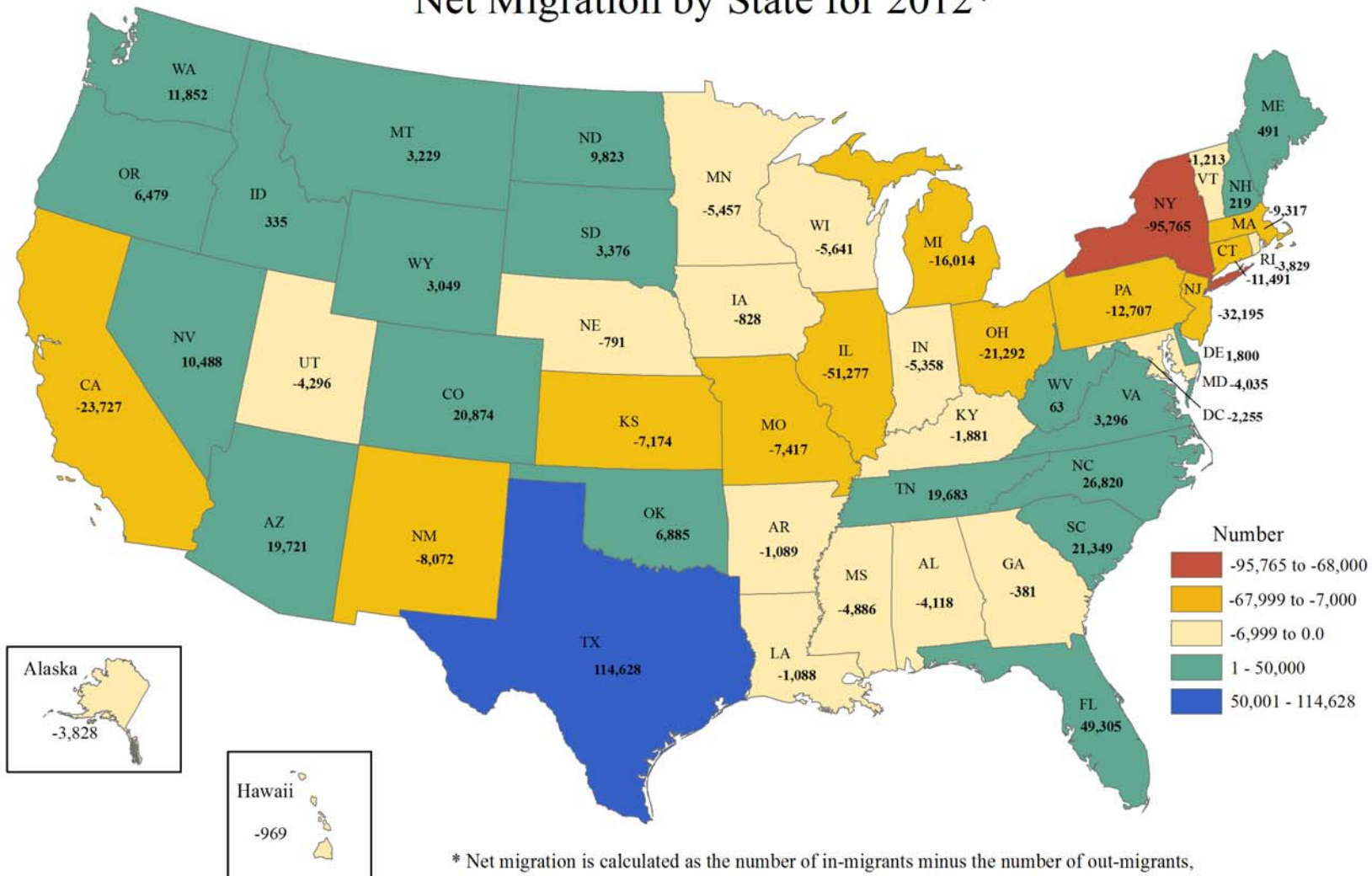

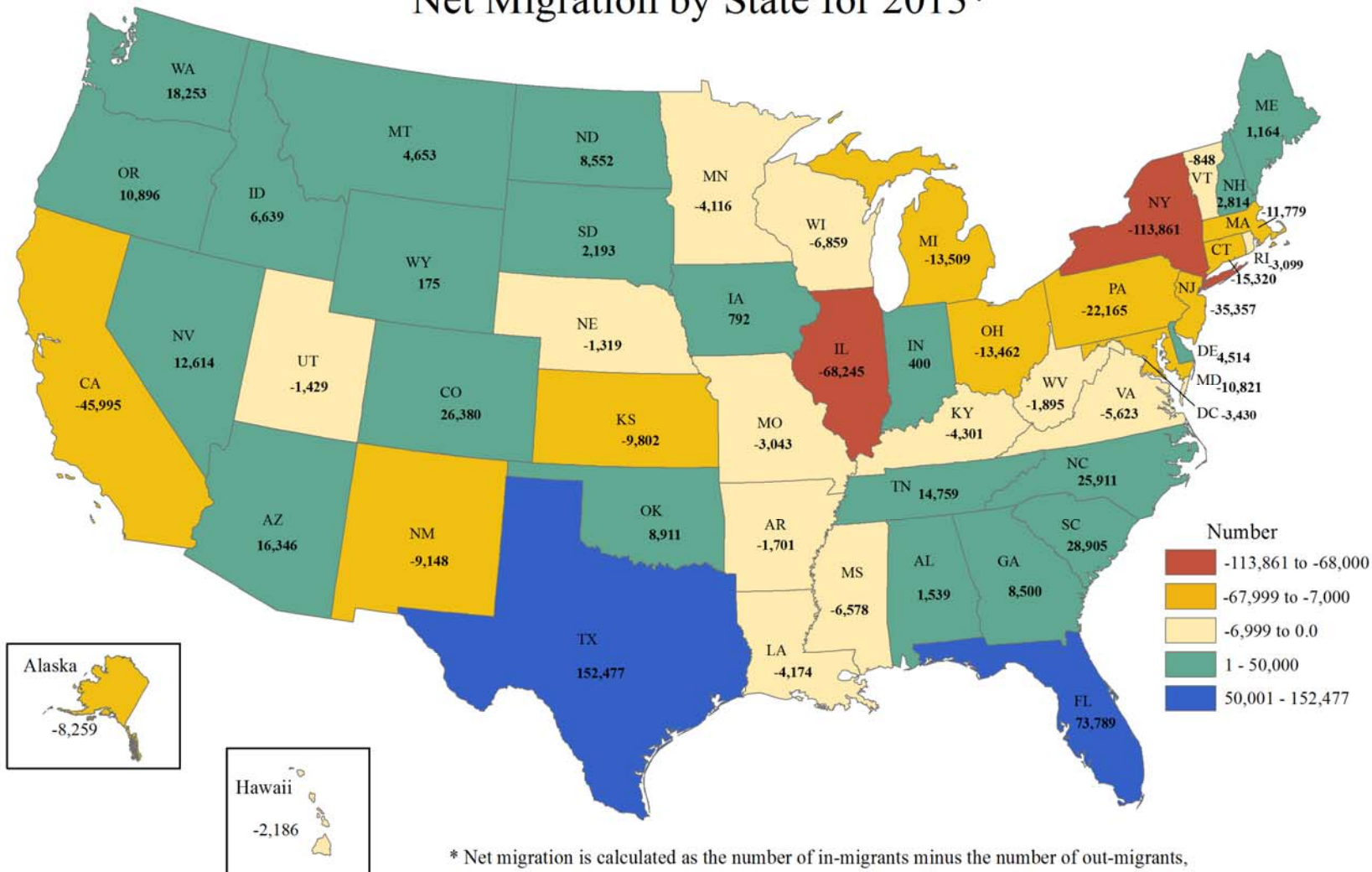

Net Migration by State for 2013*

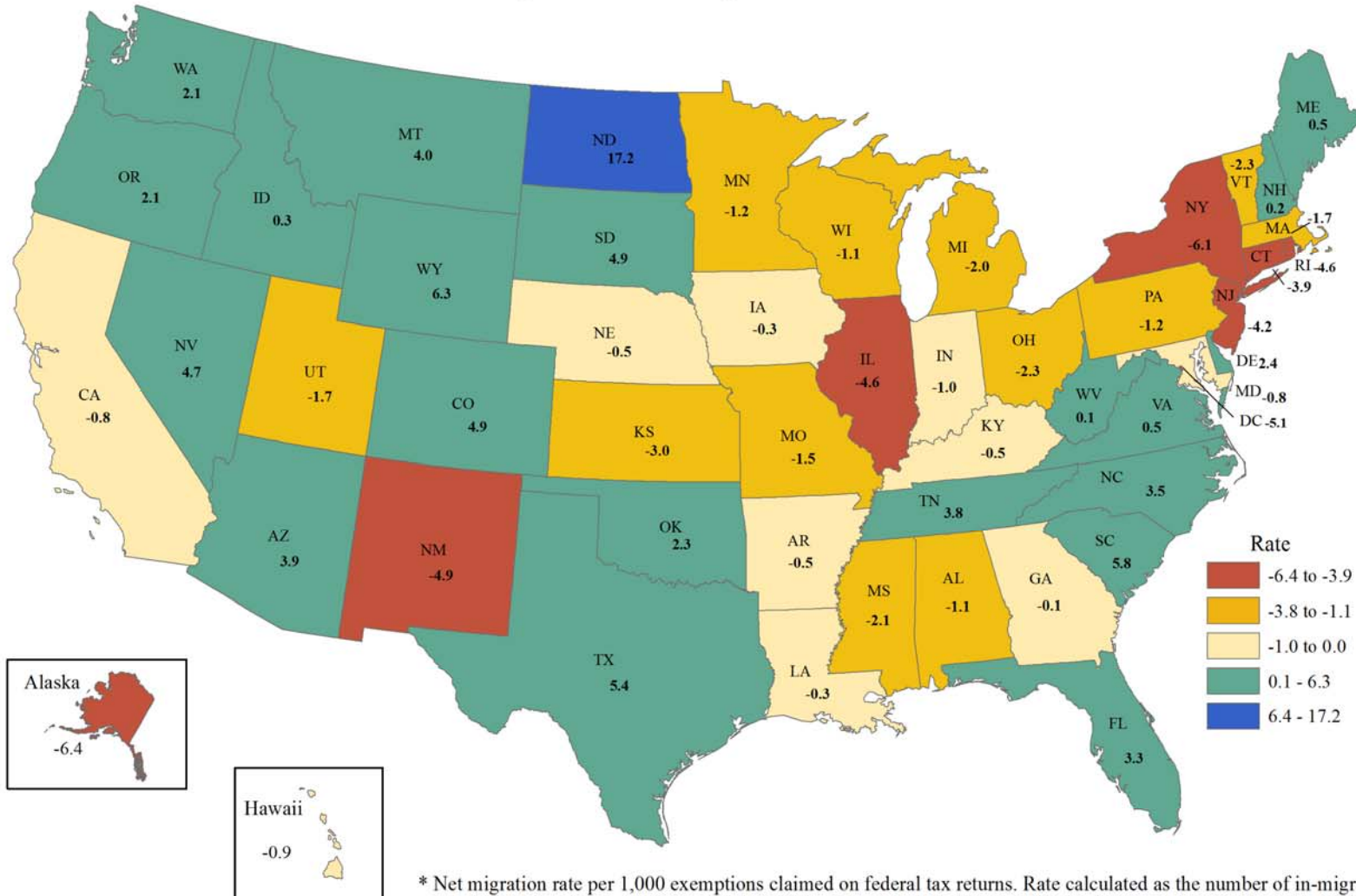

Net Migration Rate by State for 2012*

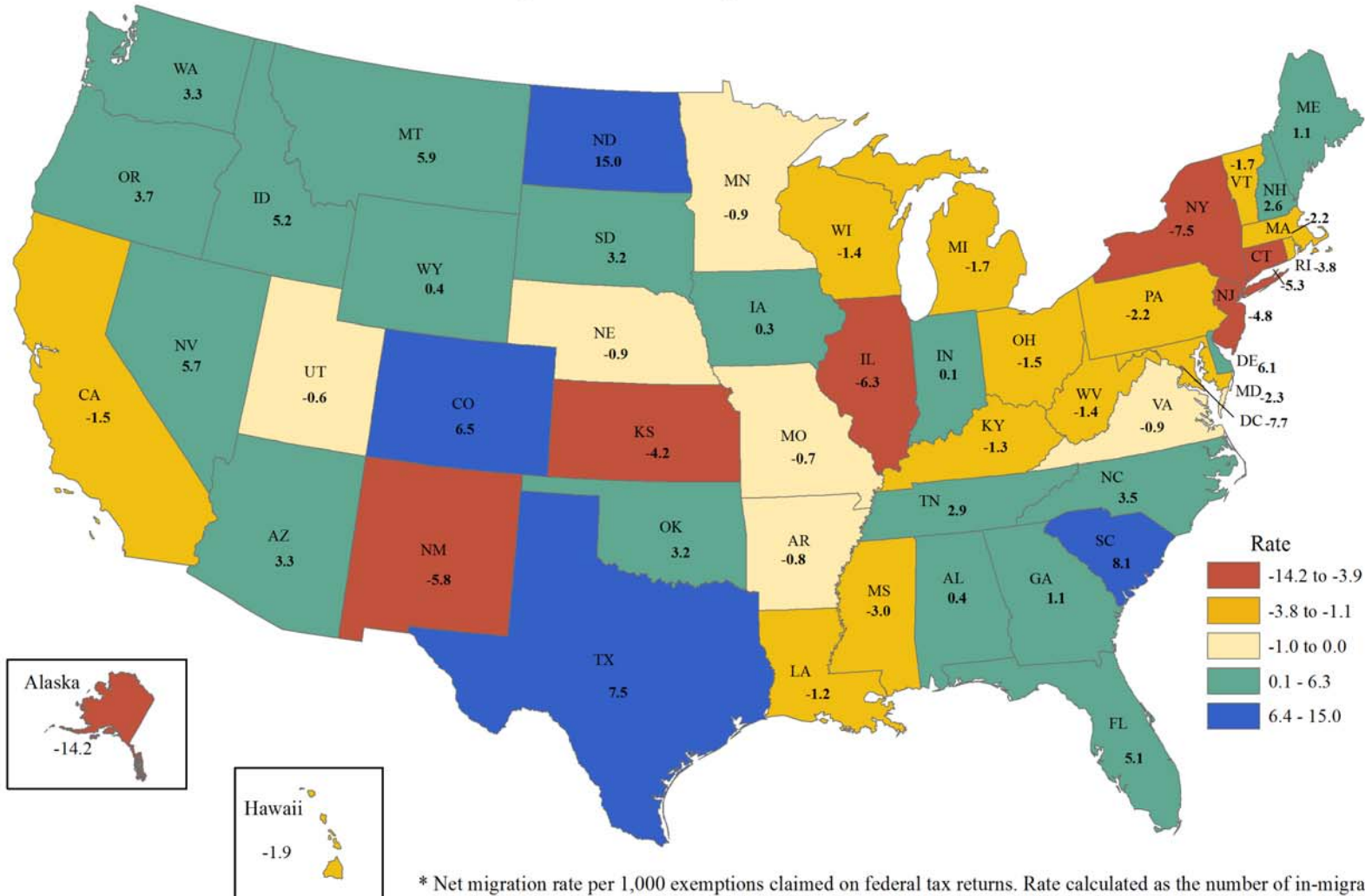

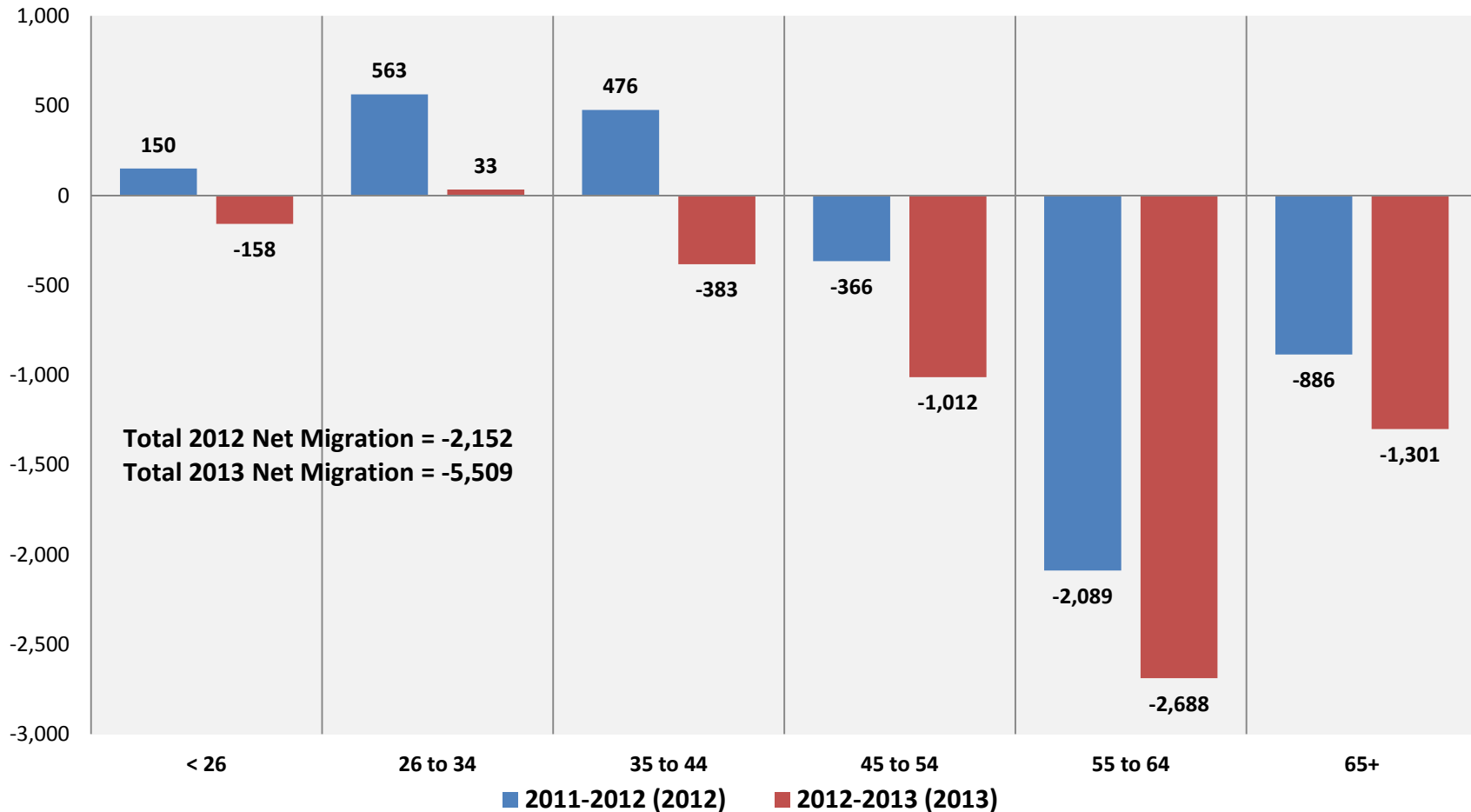

Net Migration by Age of Primary Tax Filer for Maryland, 2012 and 2013*



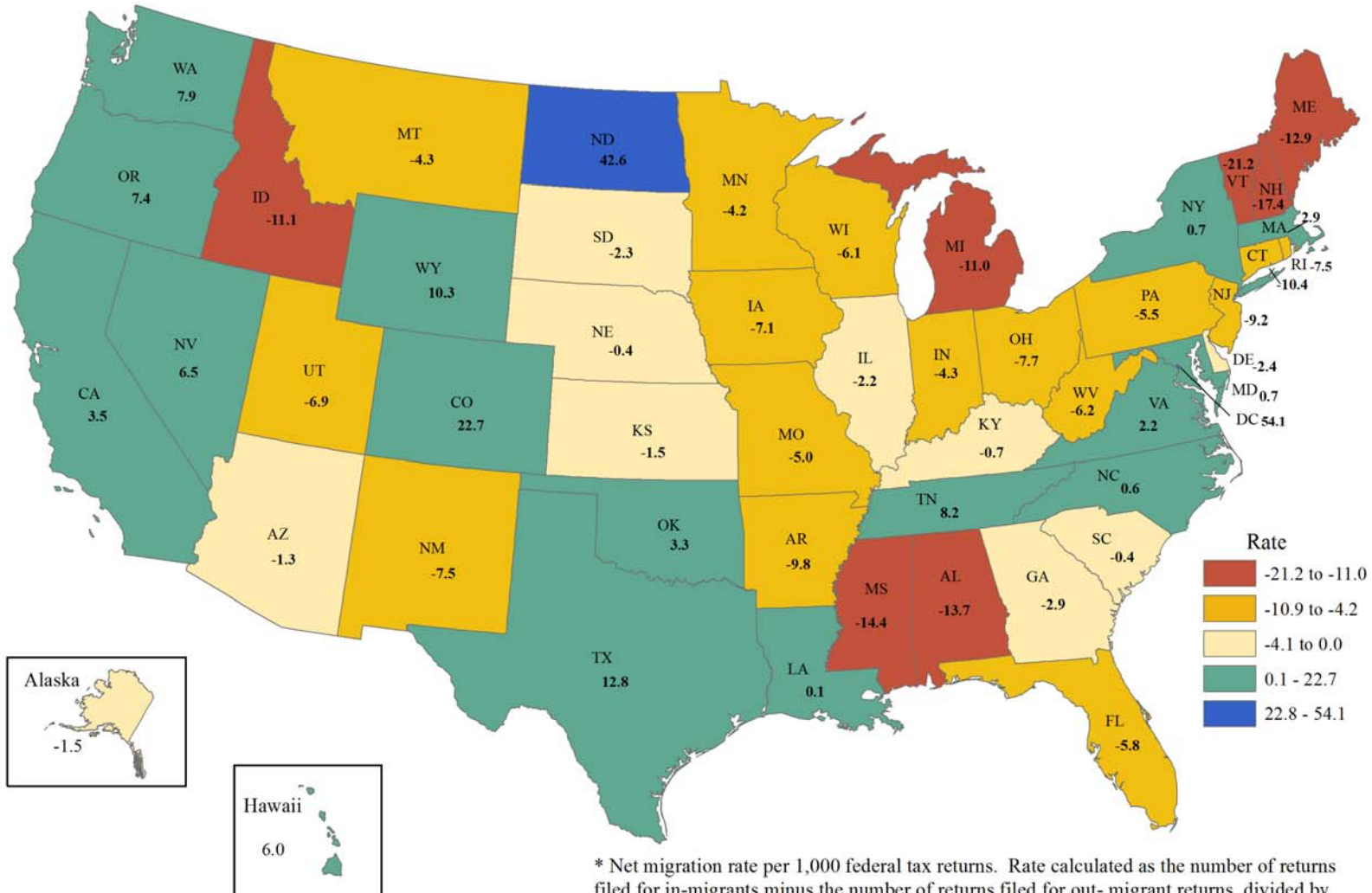

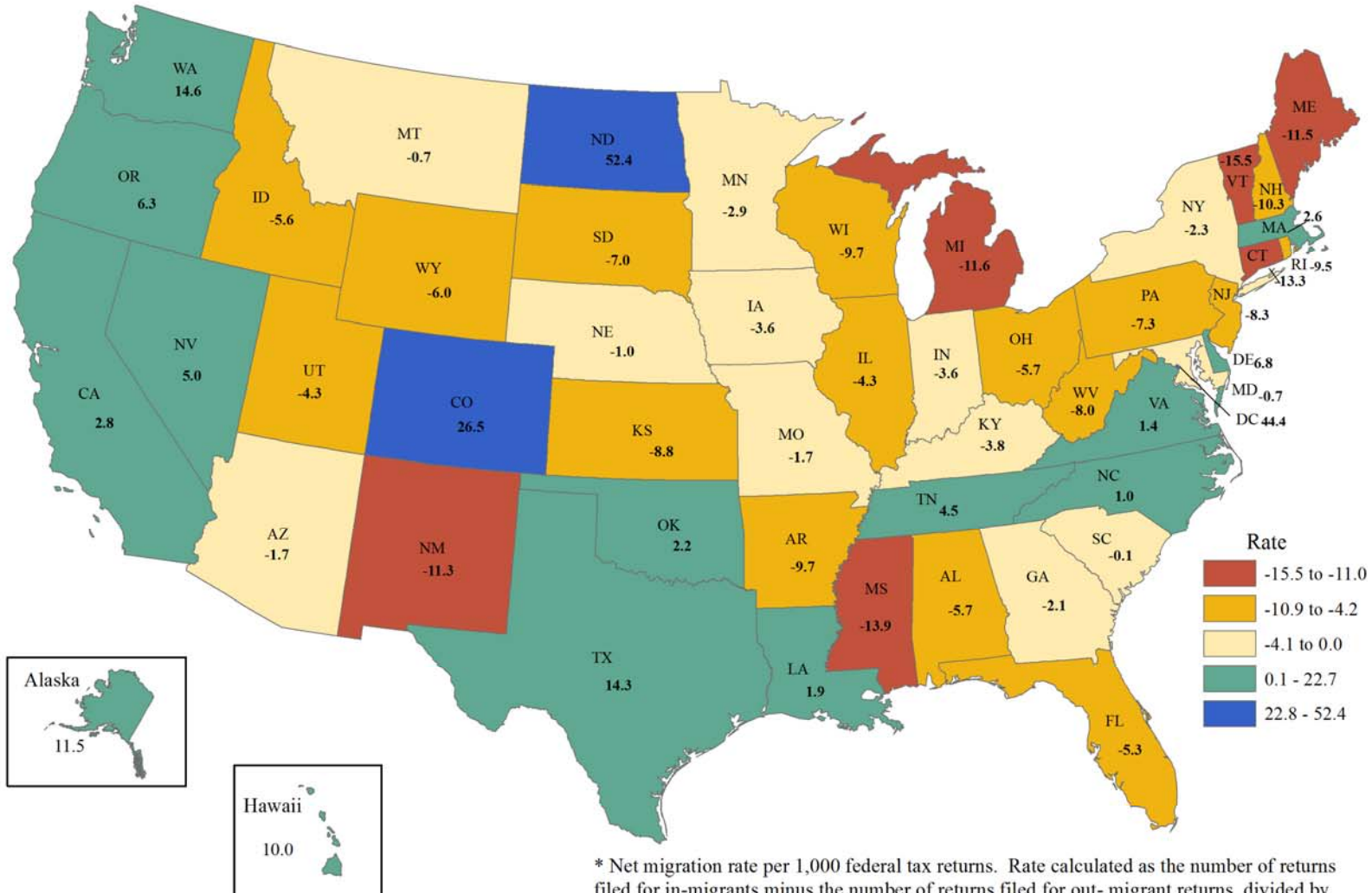

Net Migration Rate by State for Returns for Primary Tax Filer Ages Less than 26 for 2013*

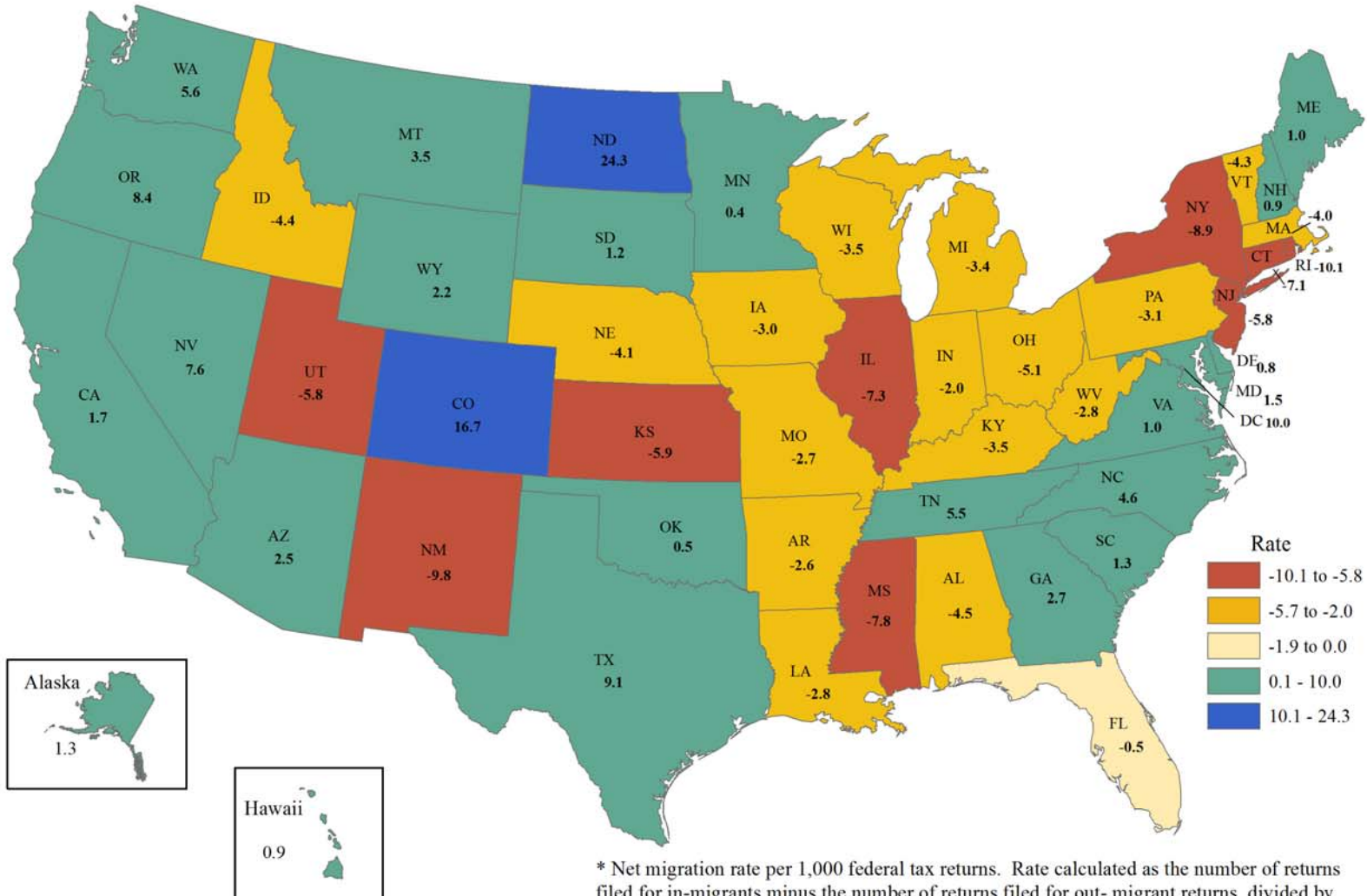

Net Migration Rate by State for Returns for Primary Tax Filer Ages 26 to 34 for 2012*

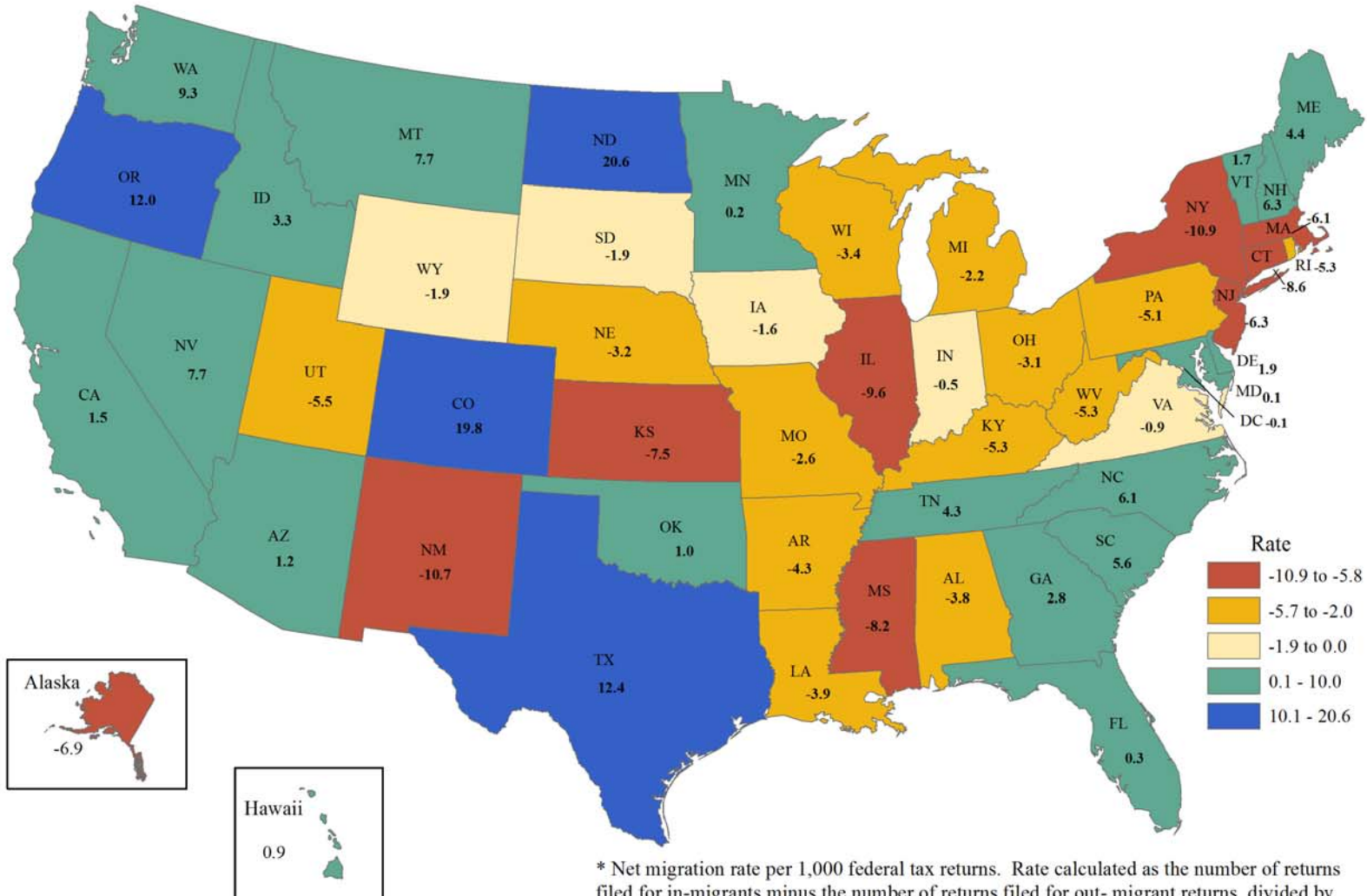

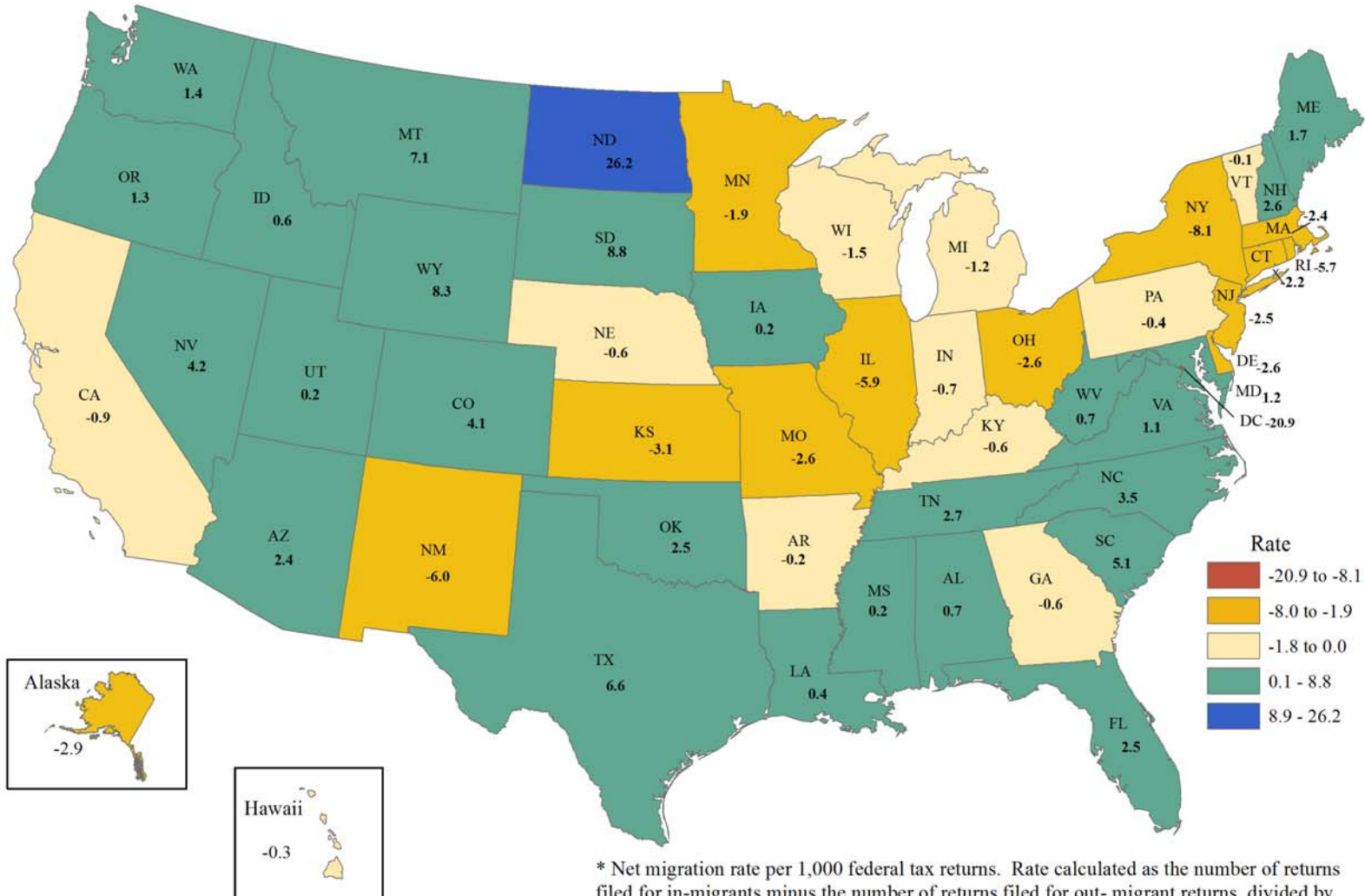

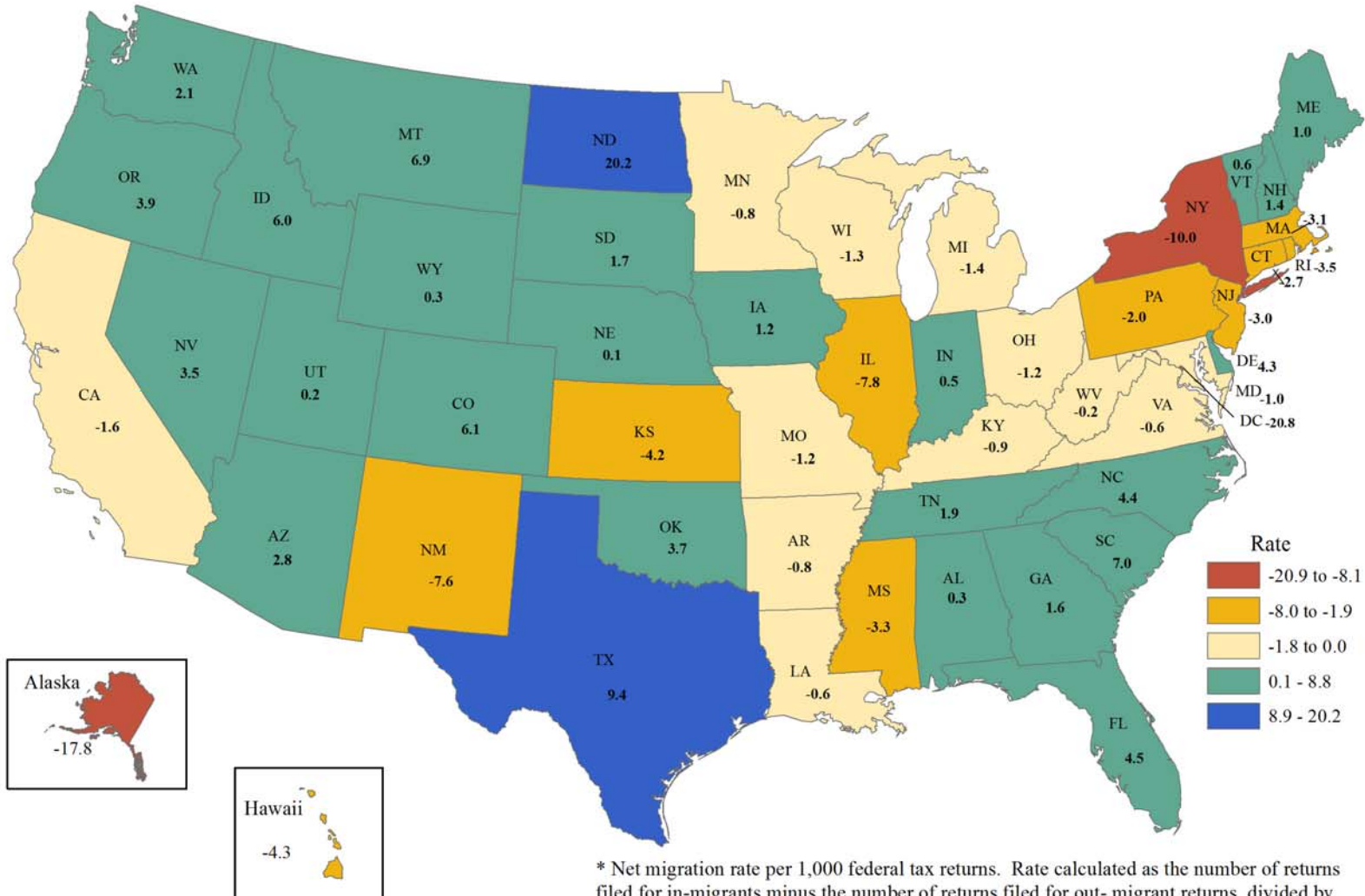

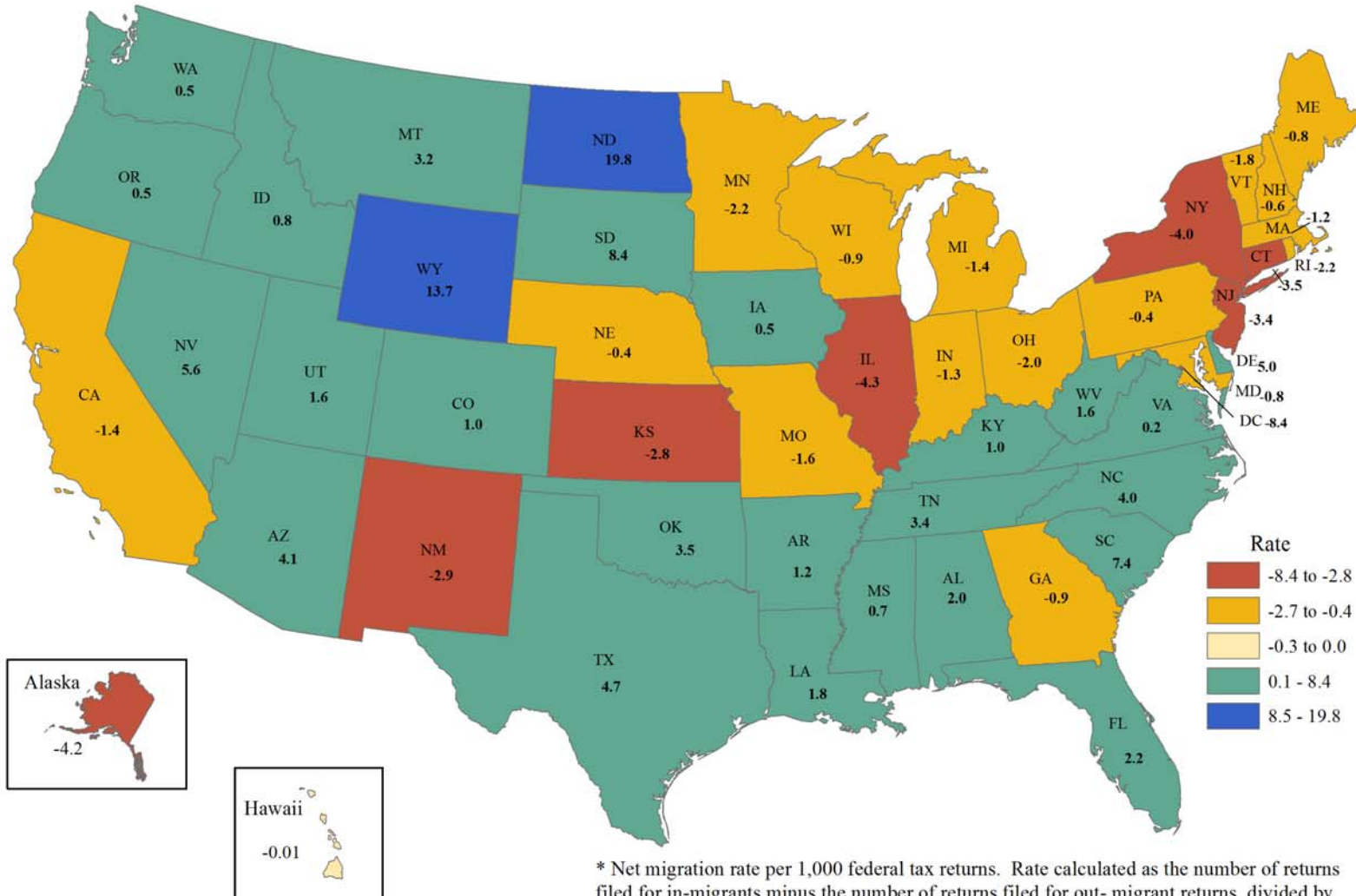

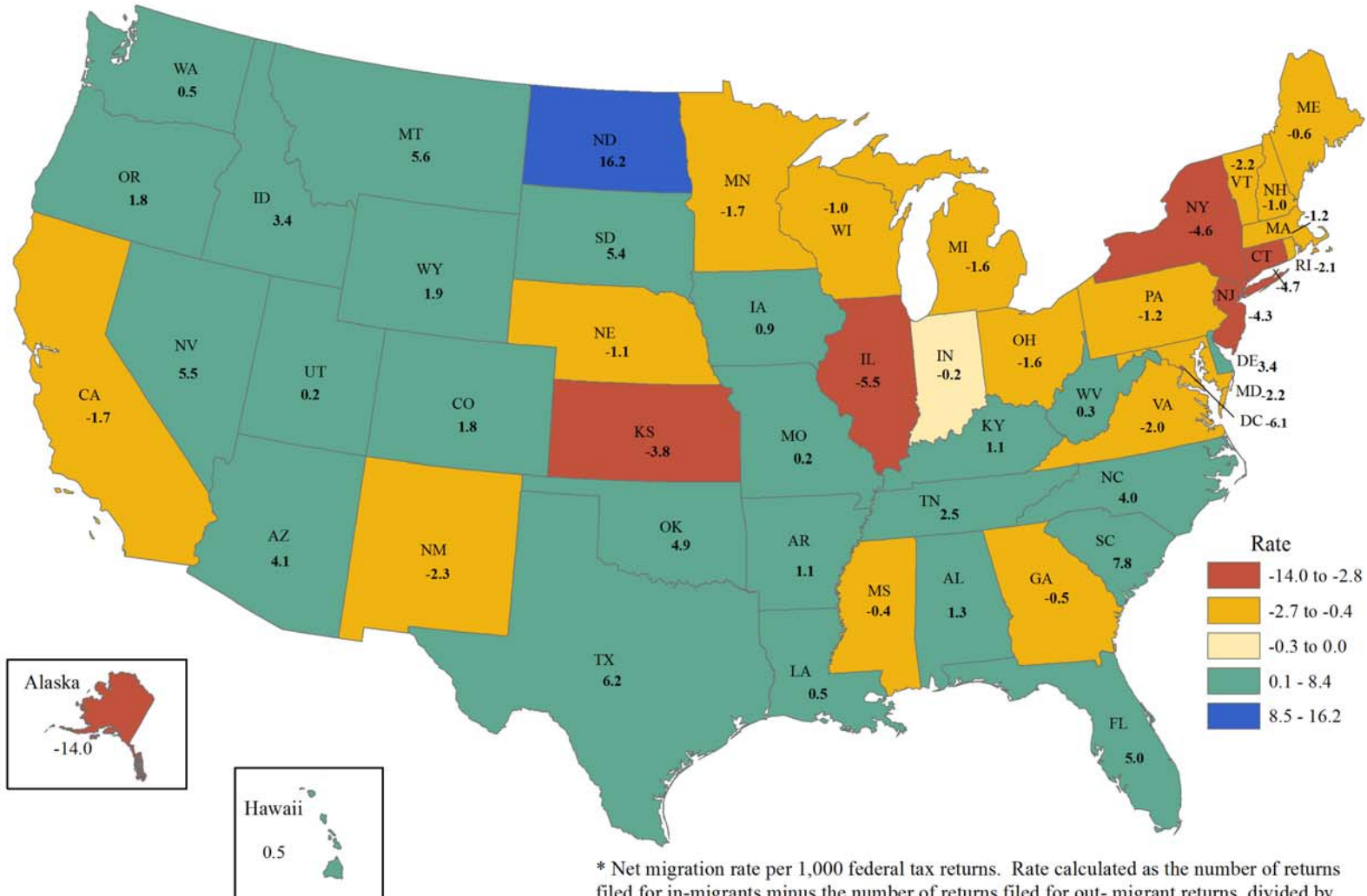

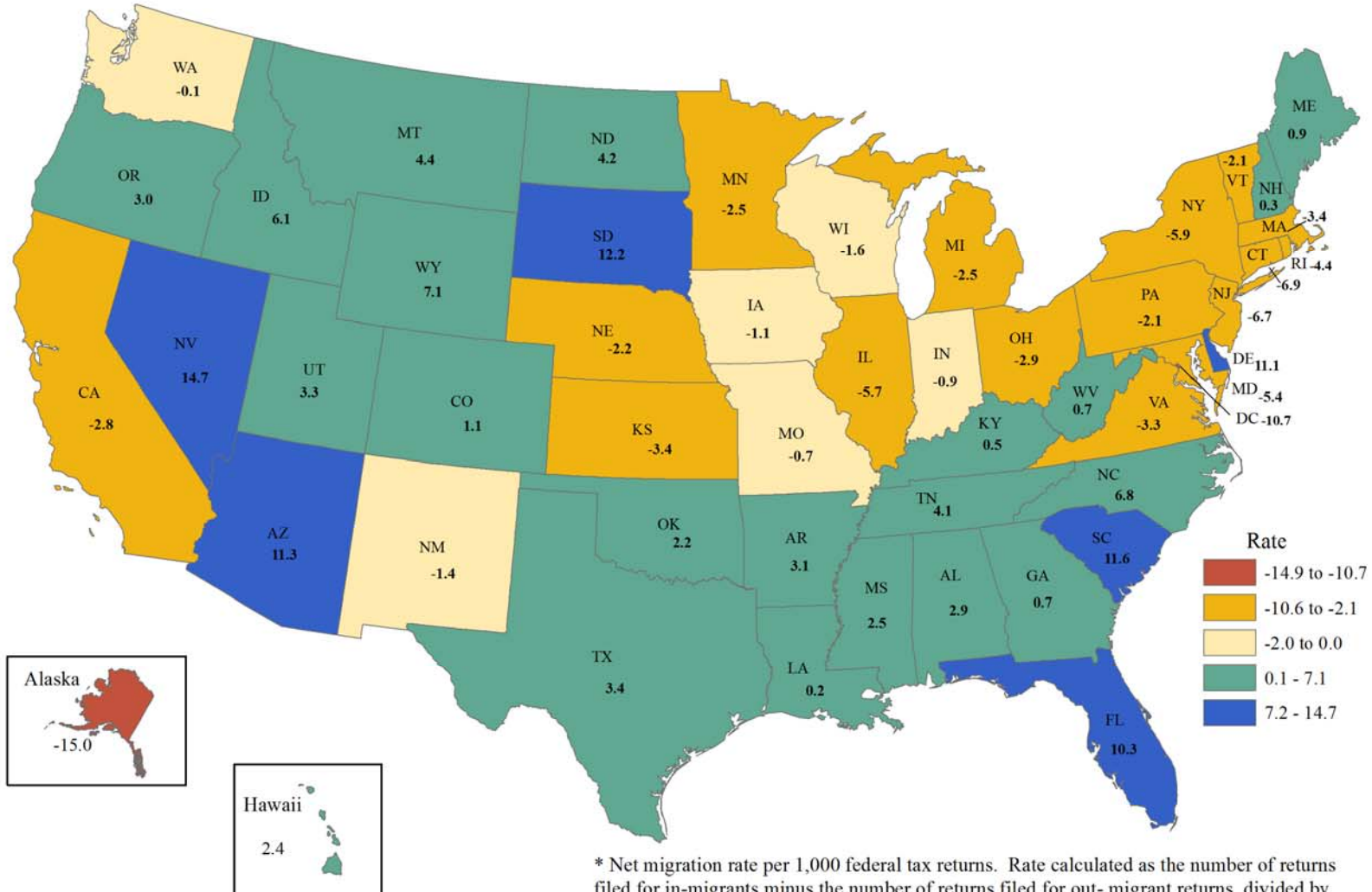

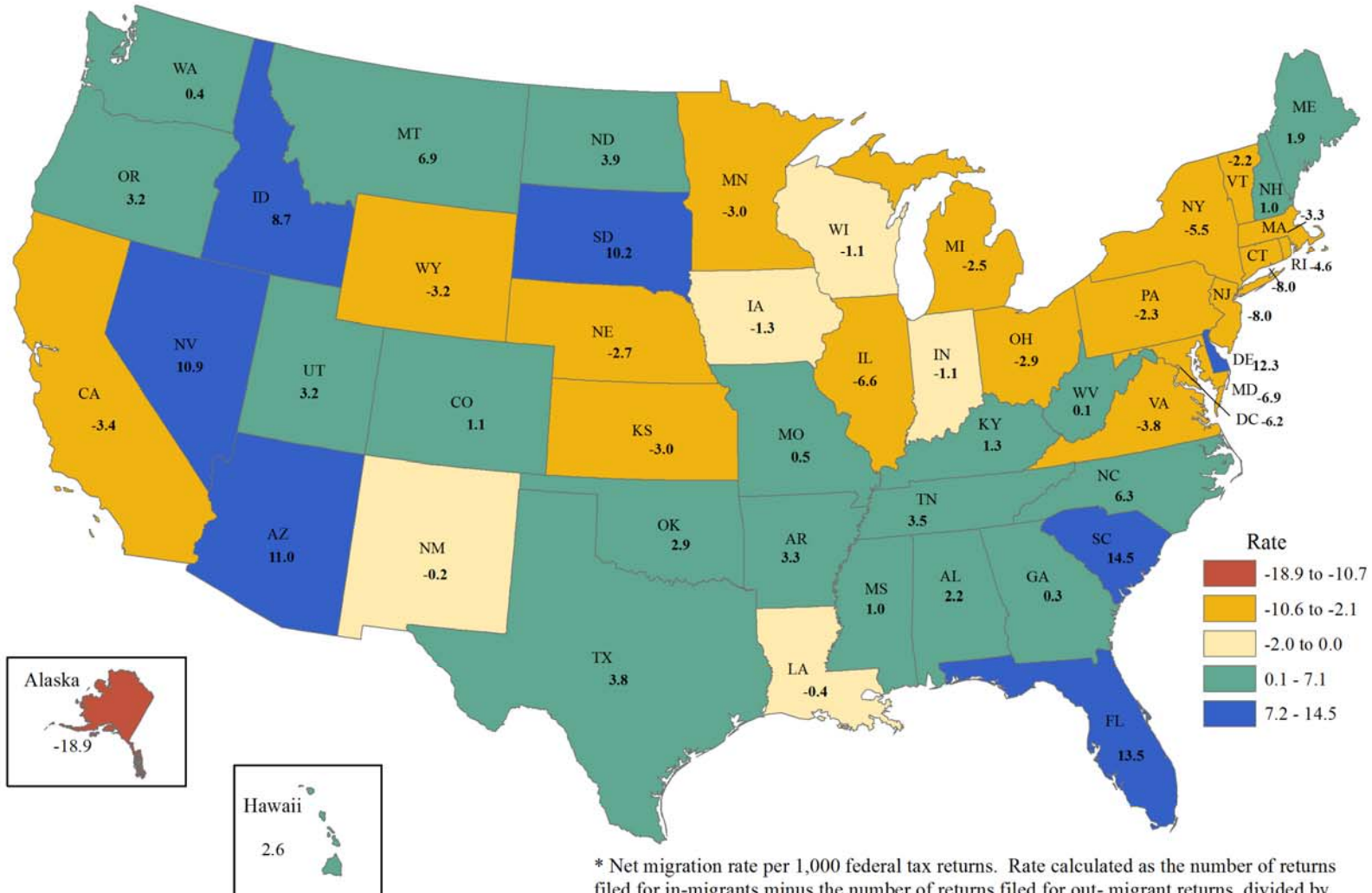

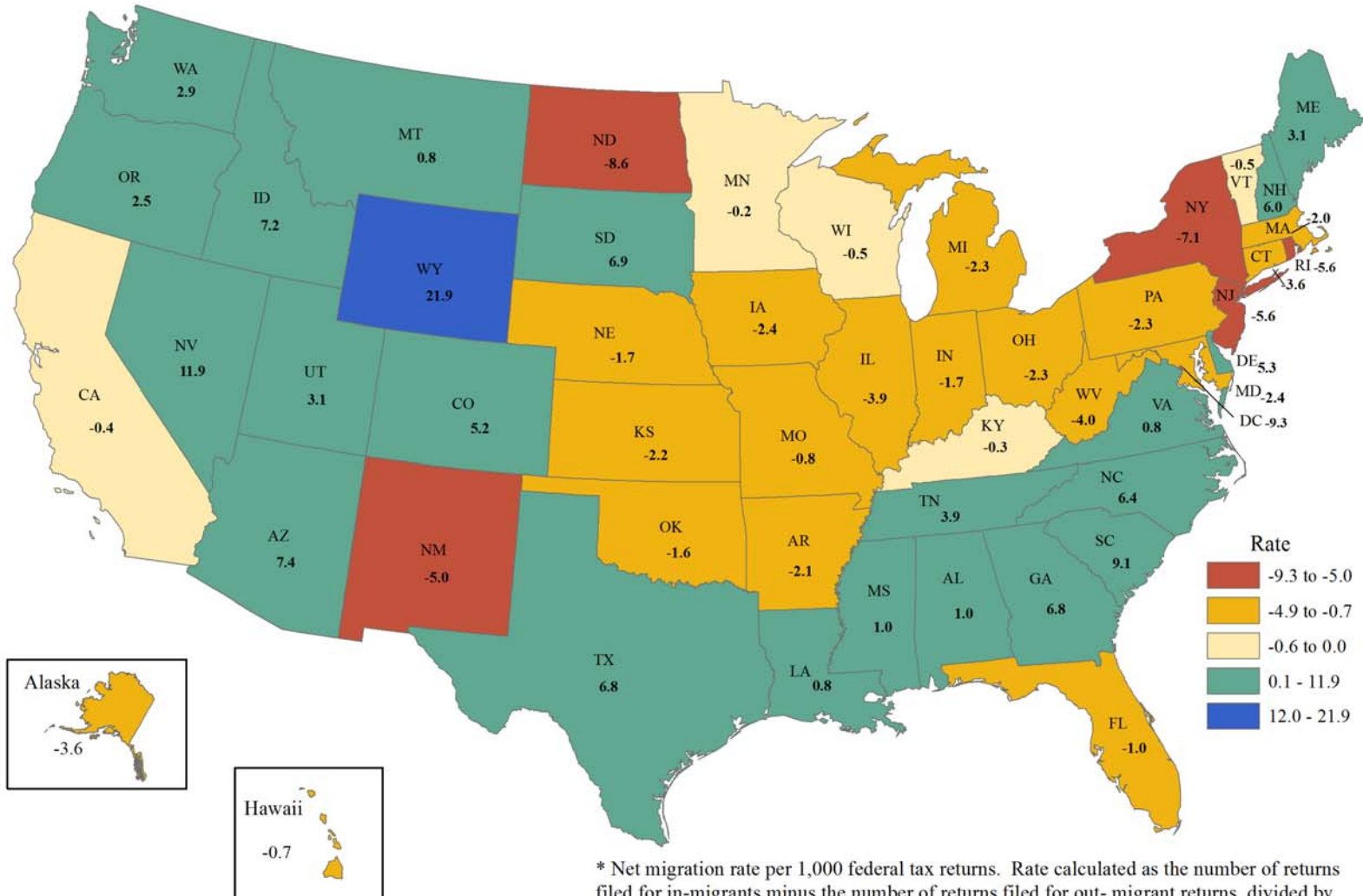

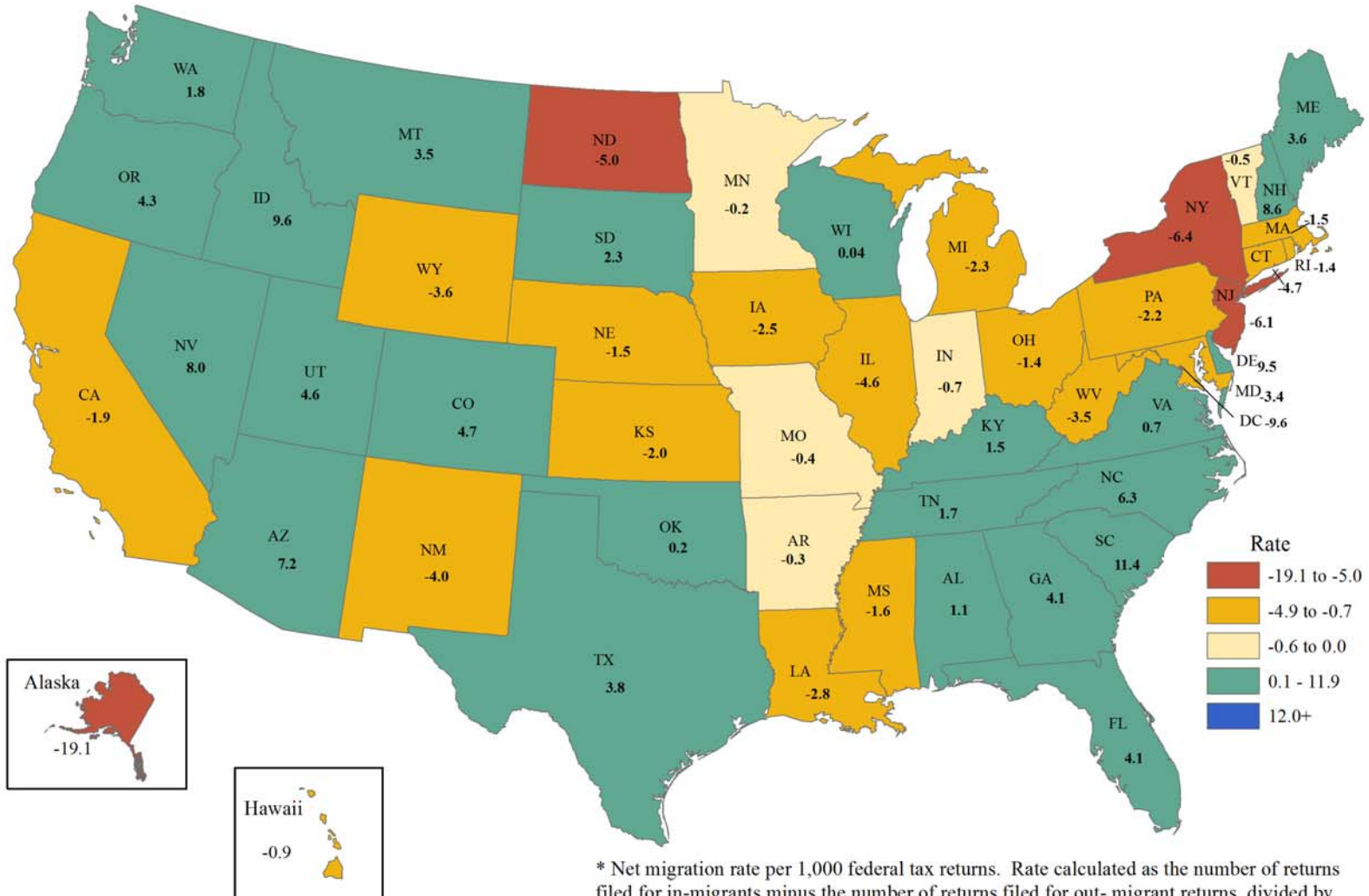

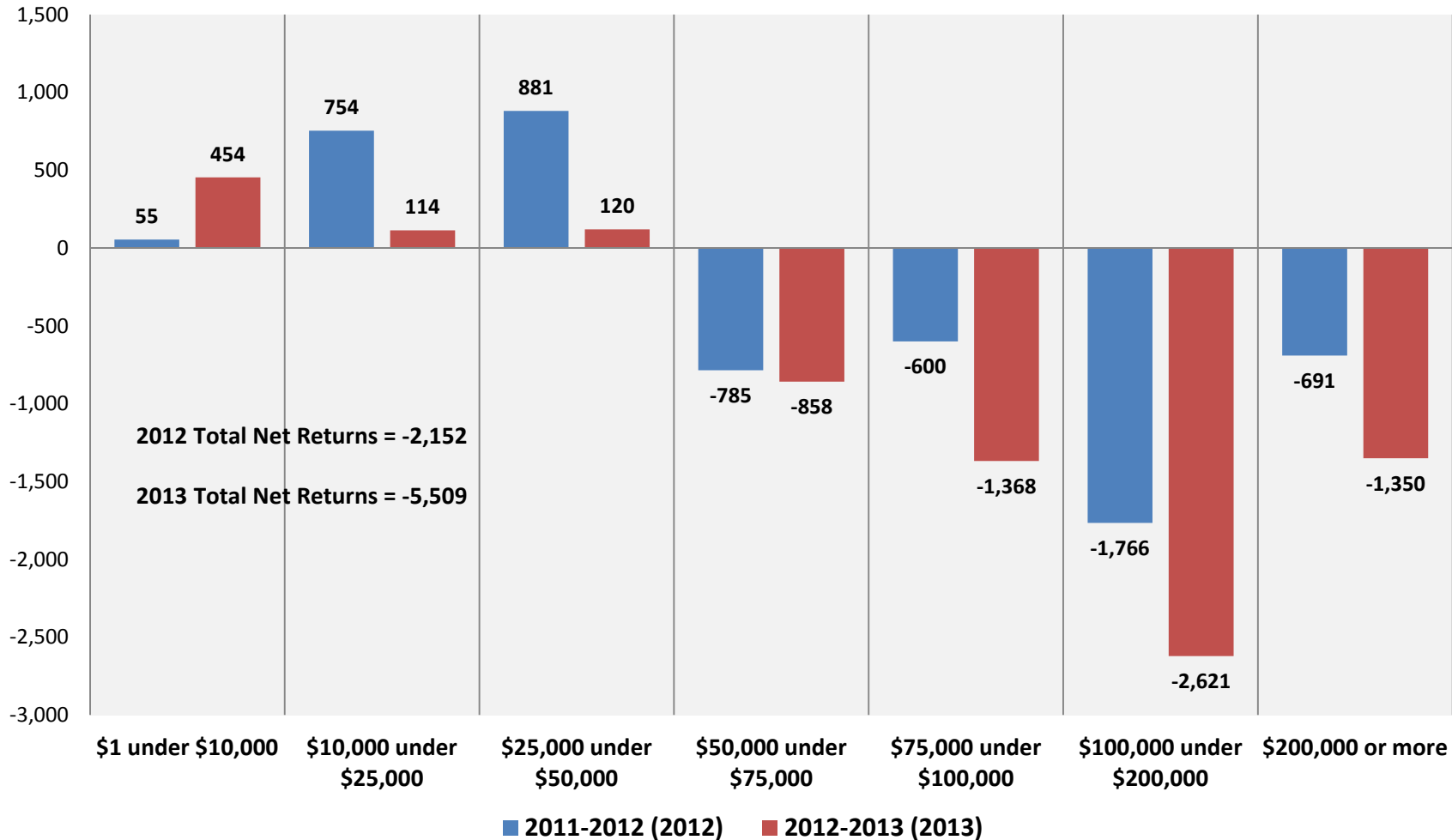

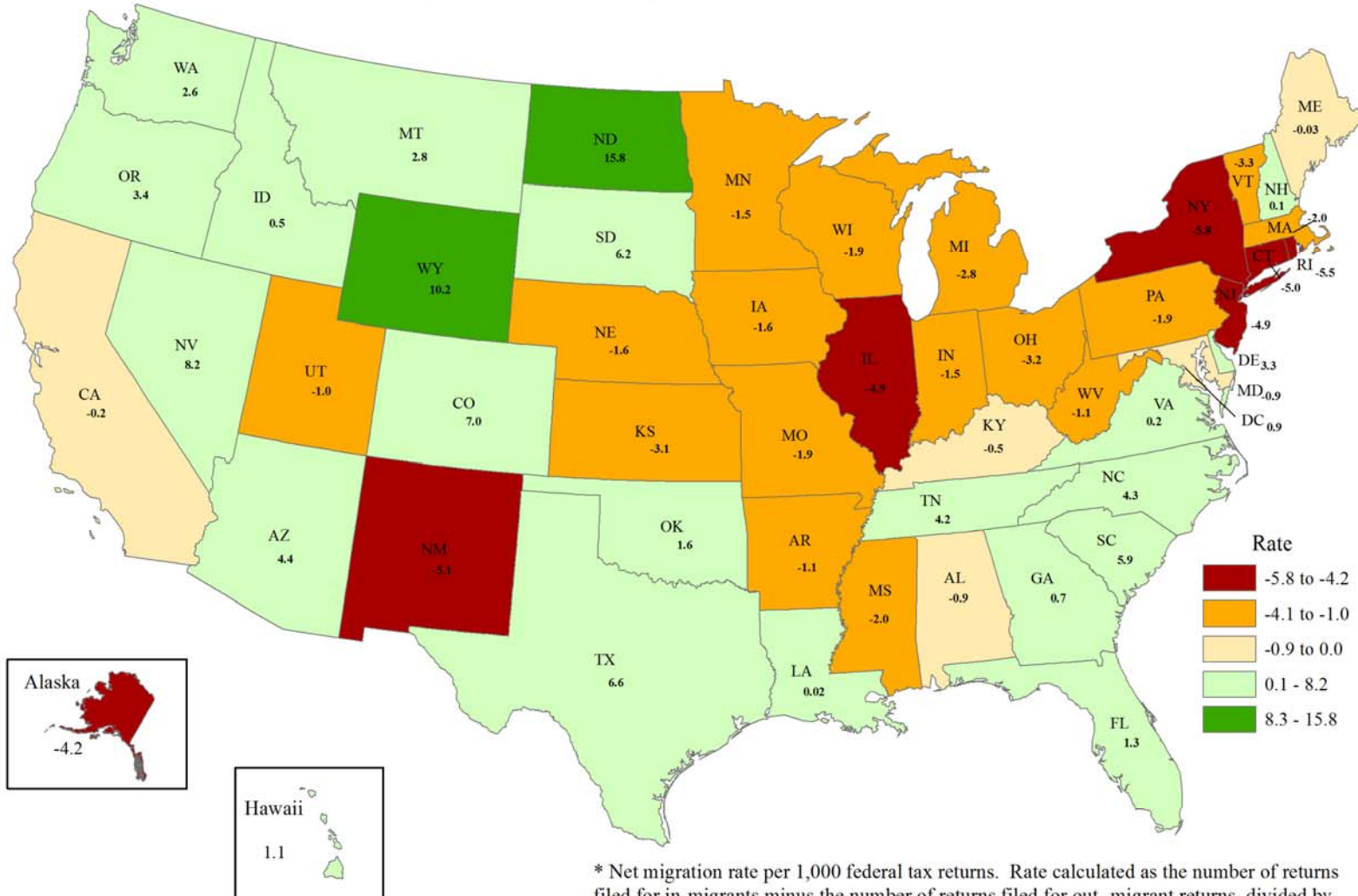

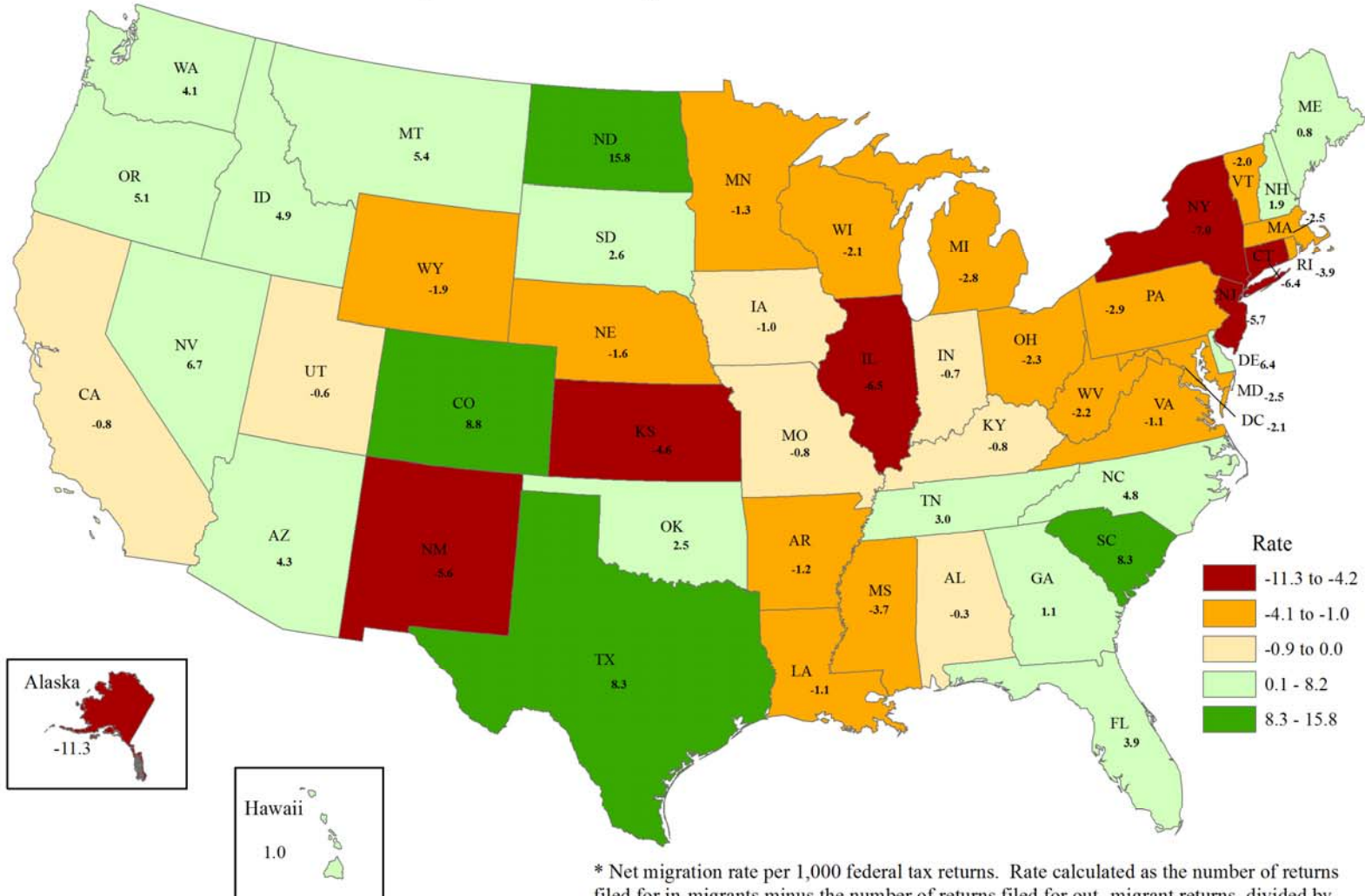

Net Migration Rate by State for all Returns for 2013*

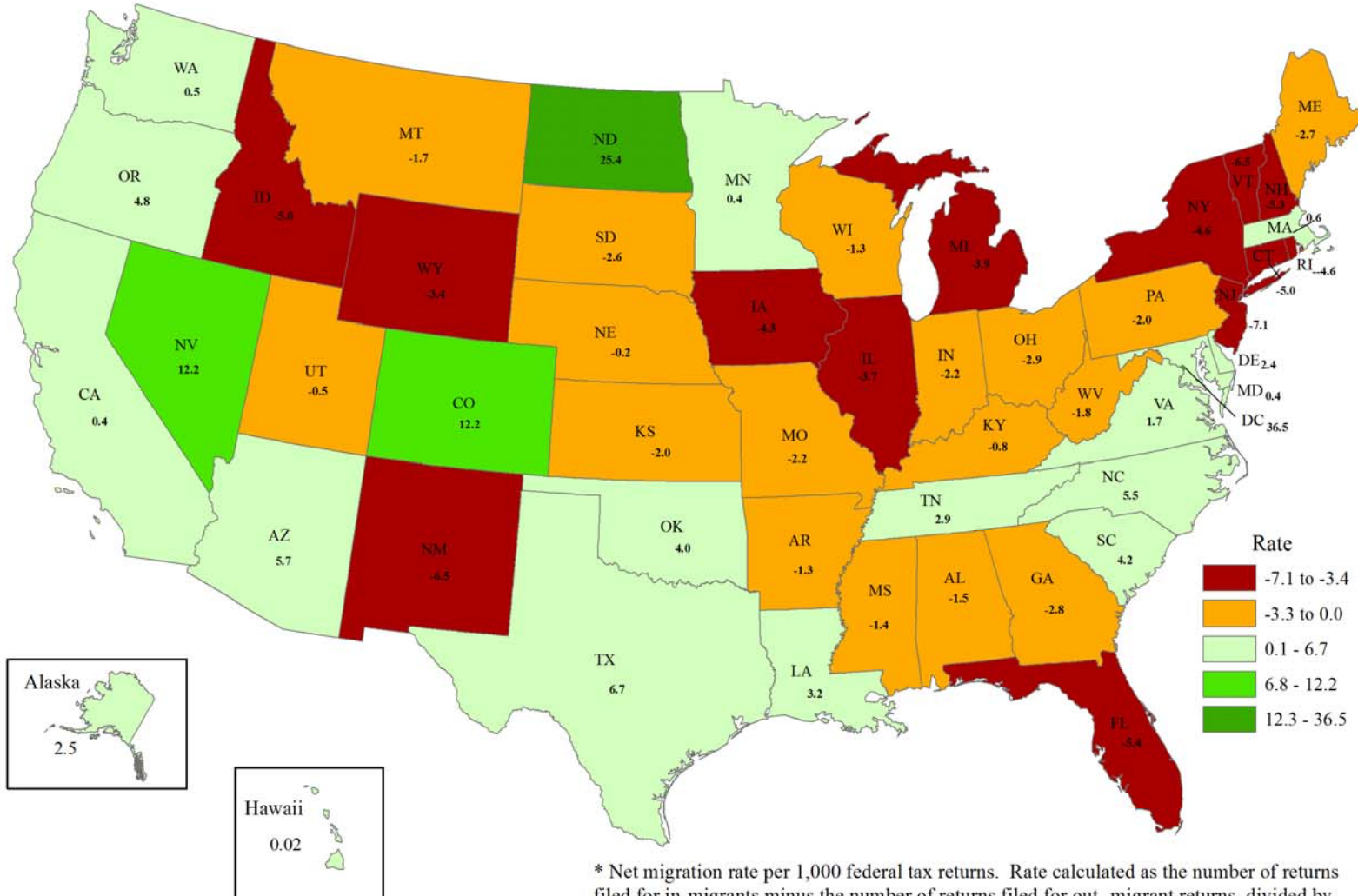


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Net Migration Rate by State for Returns \$1,000 to \$9,999 for 2012*

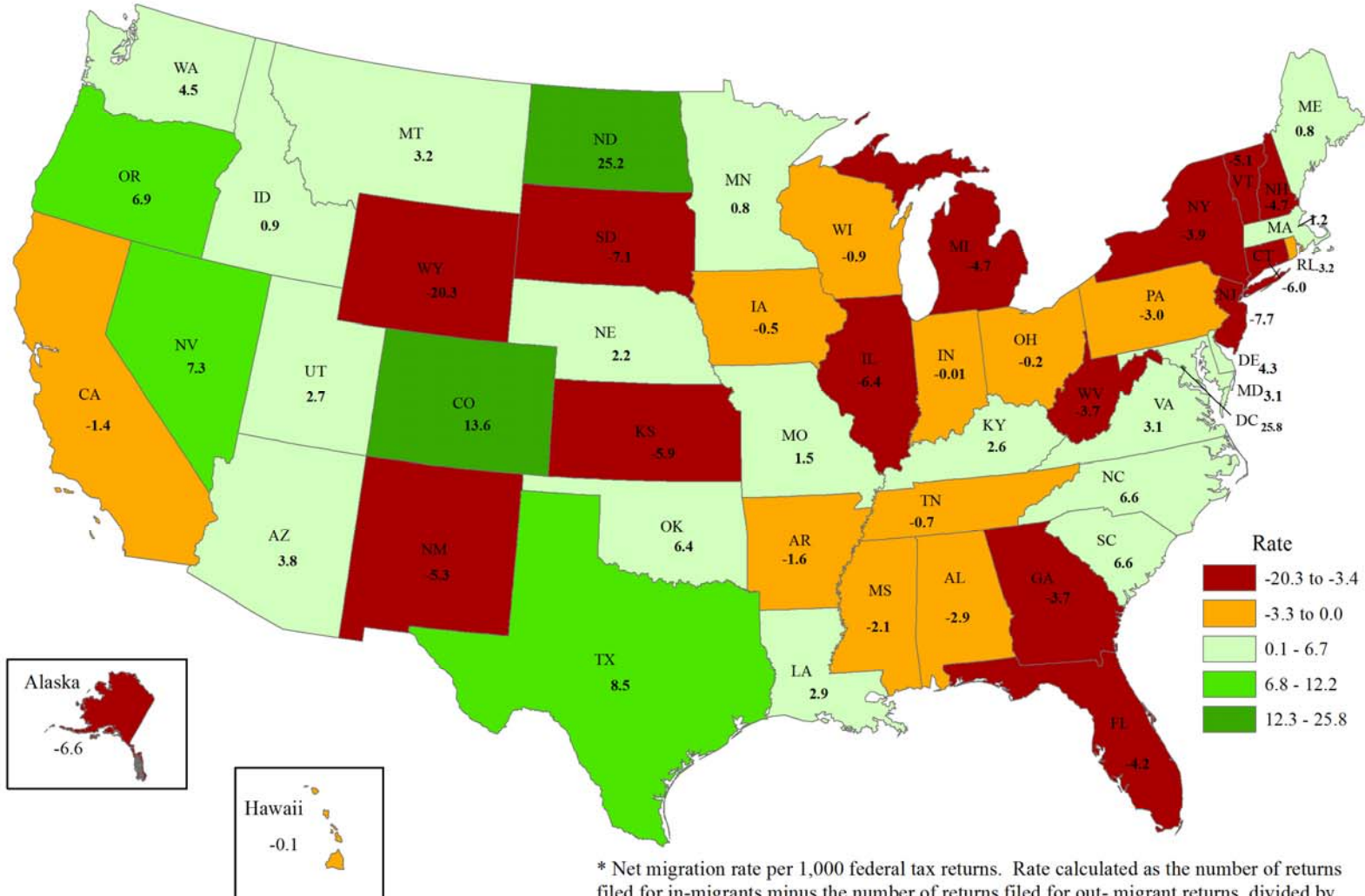

Net Migration Rate by State for Returns \$1,000 to \$9,999 for 2013*

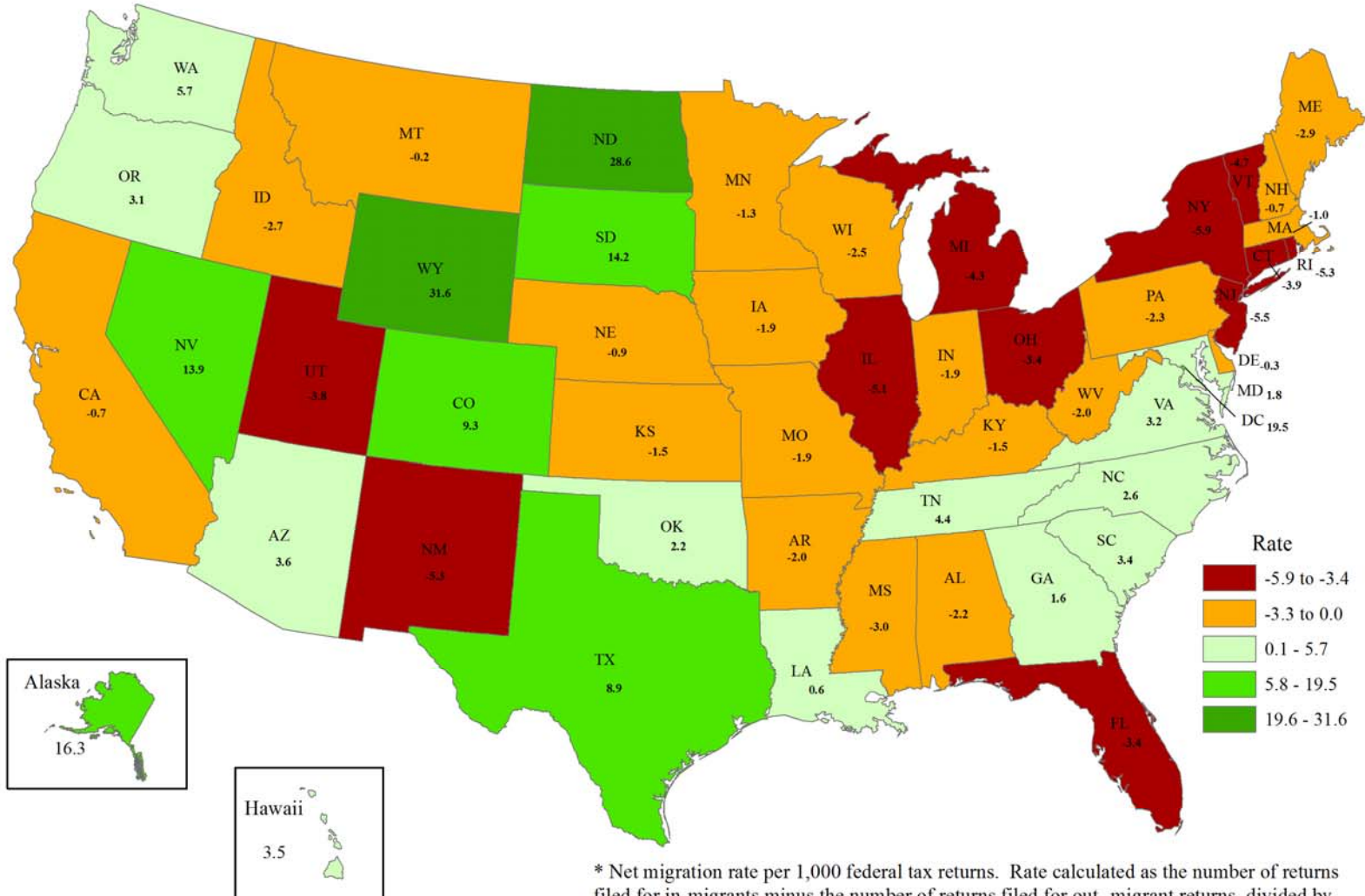

Net Migration Rate by State for Returns \$10,000 to \$24,999 for 2012*

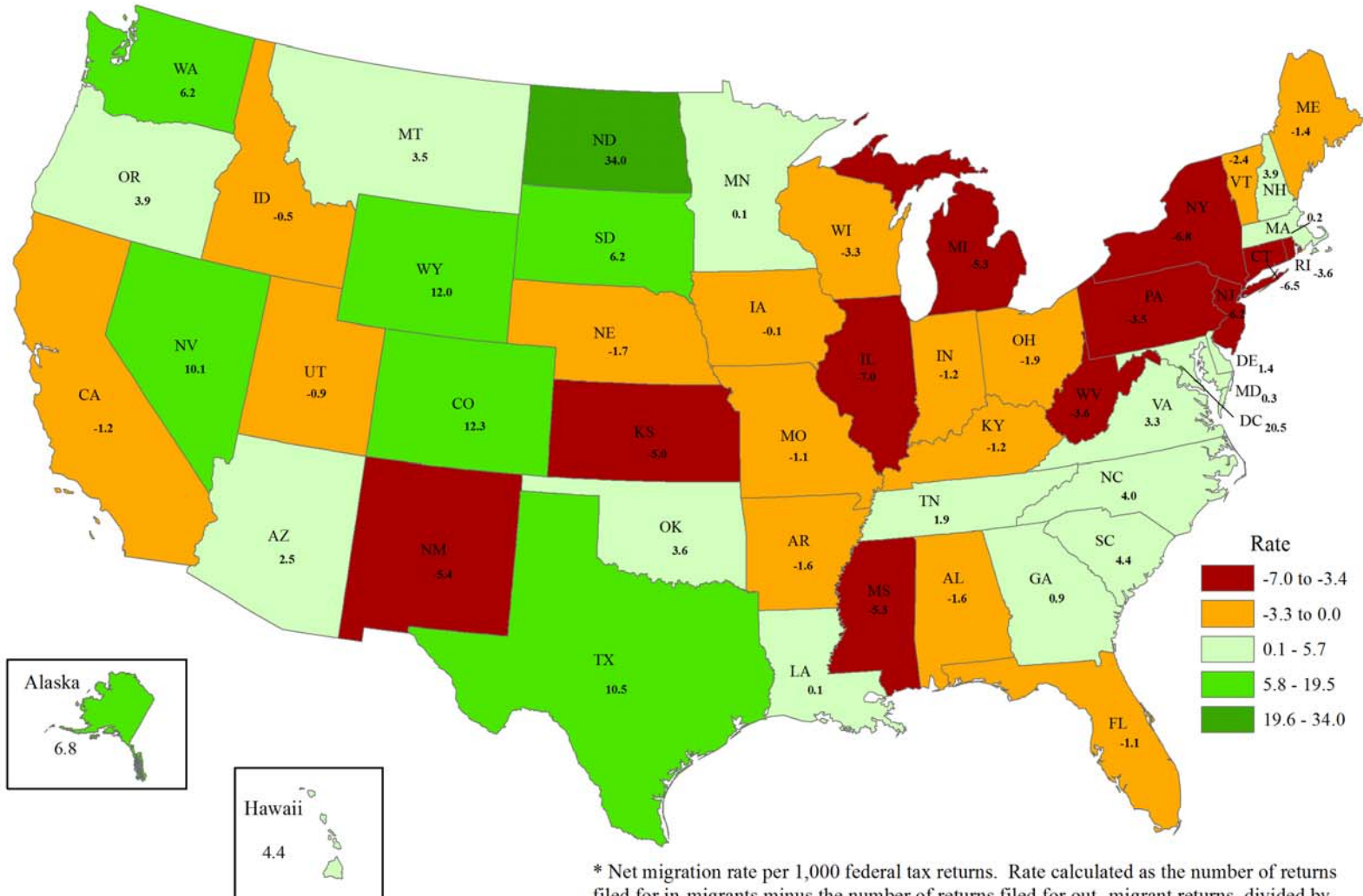

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Net Migration Rate by State for Returns \$10,000 to \$24,999 for 2013*

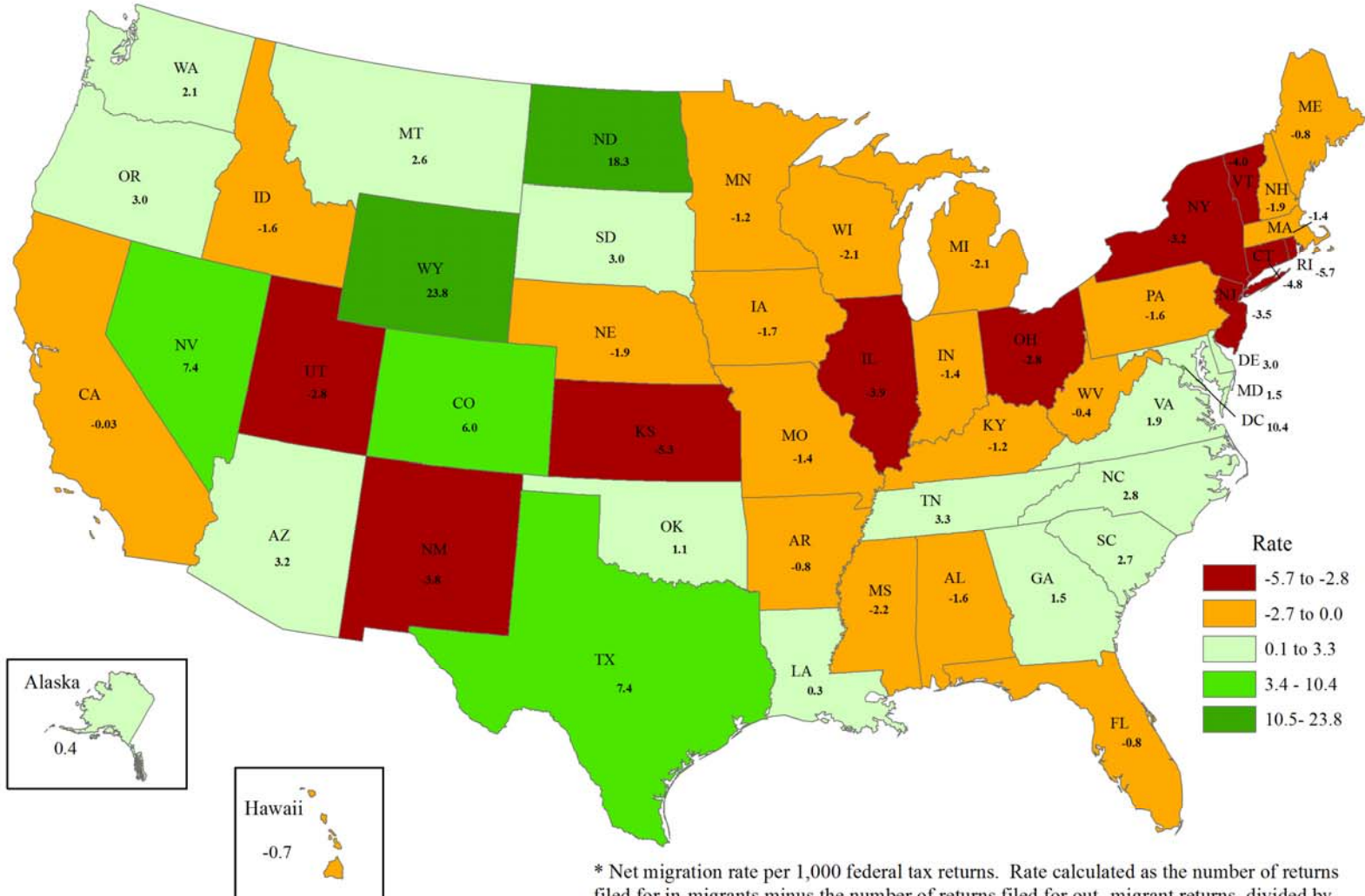

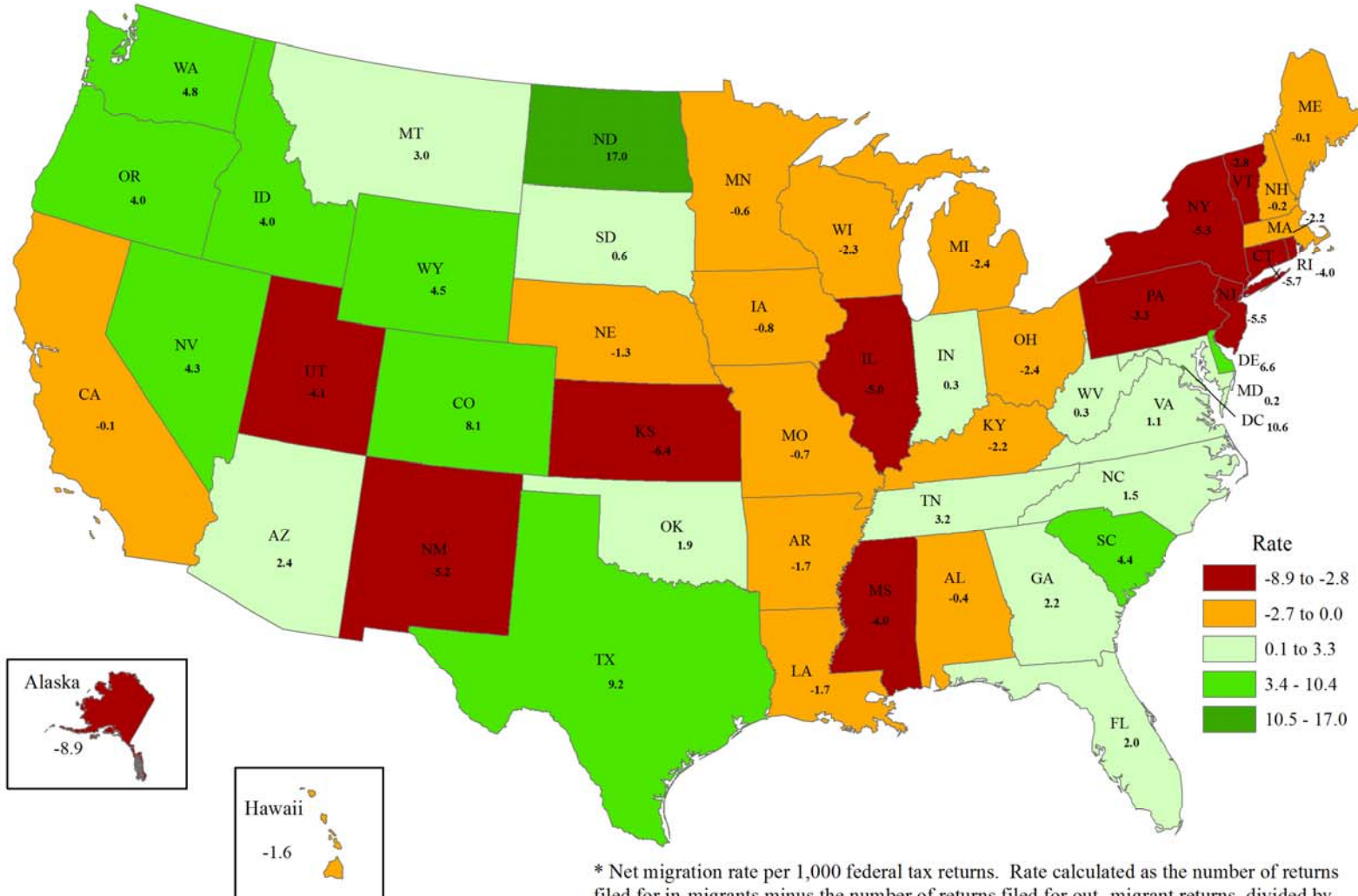
