**Note:** This report is based on Census 2020 P.L. 94-171 Redistricting Data (Maryland) and is **ADJUSTED** for the use of Maryland Redistricting pursuant to the "No Representation Without Population Act" (SB 400\HB 496) signed into Maryland law in 2010. Maryland census data **must be ADJUSTED** for the purposes of creating congressional, state legislative, and local districting plans. Generally, the law requires that the census data must be adjusted to reassign Maryland residents in State & Federal correctional institutions to their last known address, and to exclude out-of-state residents in correctional institutions from redistricting.
